- When:** April 30-May 3, 2020 (Thursday afternoon thru Sunday noon).
- Directions:** Travel on Hwy. 101 South of Lincoln City to MP 119 (1/2 mile south of Schooner creek), Left on S. Drift Creek Rd. 1 1/2 miles, right for 1/2 miles and Park is on your right. **(Note: Do not use your GPS).**
- Costs:** Camping fees are \$25.00 per day per rig. Rally fees are \$15.00 for each attendee for the total time of the rally. For Charity Auction, please bring a \$20.00 RV, hand made or nonperishable food item for the silent auction and Westerners a \$50.00 auction item from your chapter for oral auction. 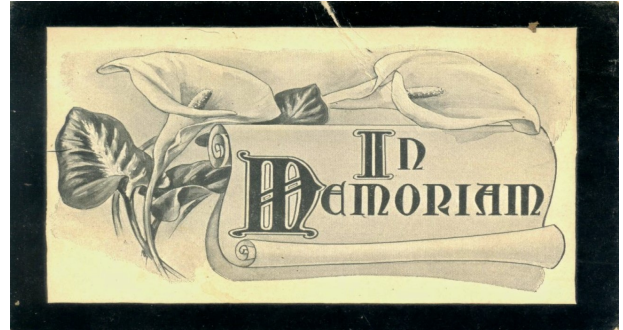
