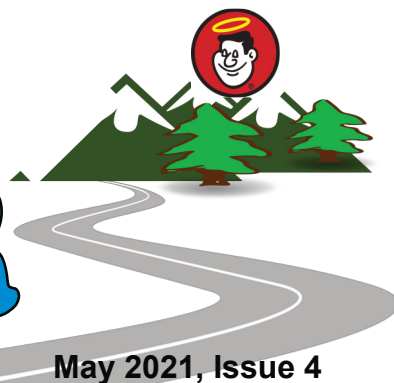

Iron Pot Breakfast

- 1 pkg of Pioneer Country Sausage Gravy mix
- 4 cups Hash browns or Tater tots
- 1 tbsp Vegetable oil
- 3 cups cooked sausage
- 3 eggs (beaten)
- 1 1/2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese

Heat dutch oven to 350
Add the oil and brown the potatoes
Sprinkle on the sausage
Mix the gravy and then add the beaten eggs to the gravy
Pour this mixture over the potatoes/sausage
Bake for 25-30 minutes or until filling is set in middle
Sprinkle on the cheese and bake 3 minutes more.
