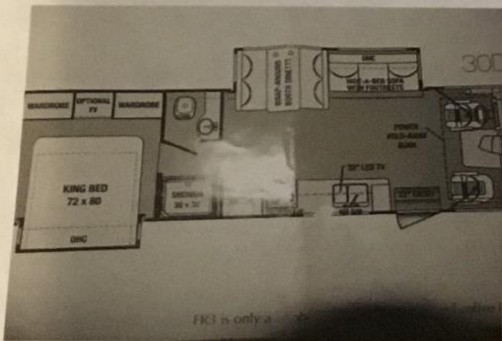

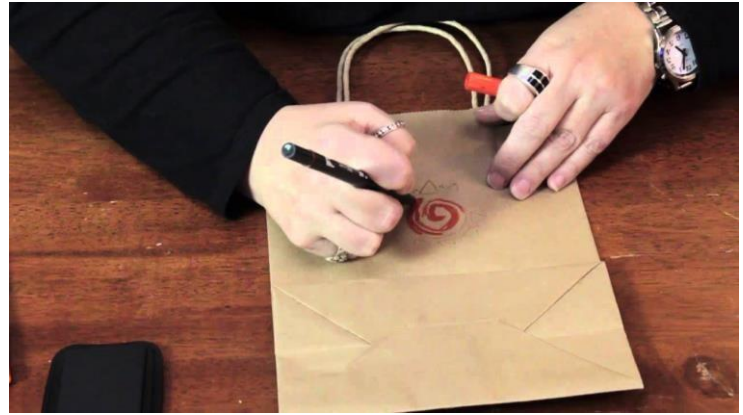

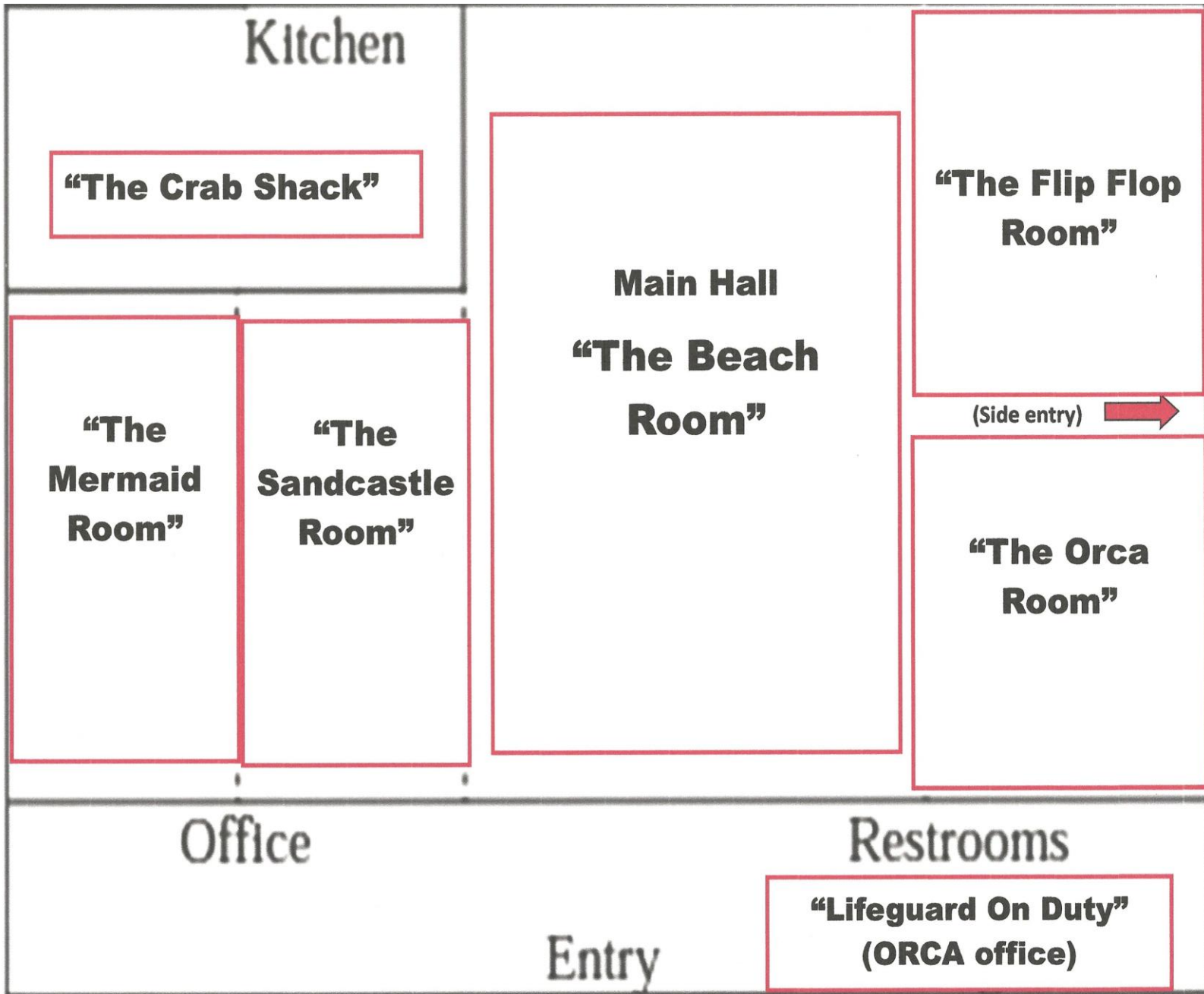
## **BROWN BAG AUCTION CHARITY FUNDRAISER**

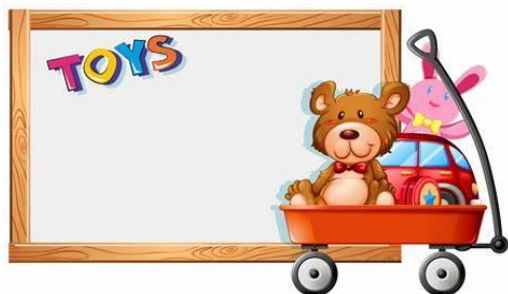

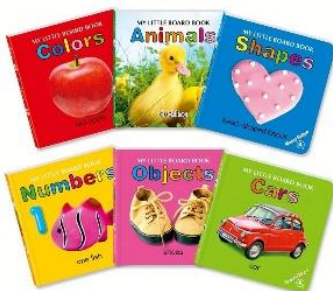
# ORCA RALLY MAP
