

The days Grand Finale was dinner at The Cowboy Dinner Tree. If you haven't been - add it to your bucket list. Reservations are required.




What are YOU Thankful For?





LEFTOVER TURKEY SAGE NOODLE SOUP

PREP TIME: 10min COOK TIME: 30min SERVINGS: 5

INGREDIENTS:

2 teaspoons oil
1 cup chopped onion
1 container (32 ounces) chicken stock
2 cups frozen peas and carrots
1 1/2 teaspoons rubbed sage
1/2 teaspoon whole thyme leaves
2 bay leaves
1 cup medium egg noodles
2 cups chopped roast turkey

INSTRUCTIONS:

Heat oil in large saucepan on medium heat. Add onion; cook and stir for 5 minutes or until softened. Add stock, peas and carrots, sage, thyme, and bay leaves; bring to boil.

Stir in noodles; cover and cook 10 minutes or until noodles are almost tender. Add turkey; cook 5 to 10 minutes or until noodles are tender and turkey is heated through. Remove bay leaves before serving.
